## **PARENT-CONTRACT**

It is the intention of this CONTRACT to promote fair play and respect for all participants within the Association. All parents must sign this pledge before being allowed to participate in hockey and must continue to observe the principles of Fair Play.

### **FAIR PLAY CODE**

- I will not force my son or daughter to participate in hockey.
- I will remember that my son or daughter plays hockey for his or her enjoyment, not mine.
- I will encourage my son or daughter to play by the rules and to resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will make my son or daughter feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and playing their best.
- I will never ridicule or yell at any participant for making a mistake or losing a game.
- I will remember that children and youth learn by example. I will applaud good plays and performances by both my child's team and their opponents.
- I will never question the official's judgment or honesty in public. I recognize officials are developing in the same manner as players.
- I will support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from hockey games.
- I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to hockey.
- I acknowledge that cell phones or other recording or photographic devices are NOT permitted in the Dressing Rooms and my child will either leave their cell phone at HOME or have it OFF AND LOCKED at all times while in the Dressing Rooms. I understand that issues surrounding cell phone use and social media are taken seriously and may be subject to disciplinary action.
- I understand that 100 Mile House & District Minor Hockey, BC Hockey and Hockey Canada have a Zero-tolerance policy on drugs and alcohol. The use of alcohol, tobacco and vape products is strictly prohibited during Minor Hockey sanctioned events (as a spectator and during practices; dryland training; fundraising; league, exhibition or tournament games and accommodations, etc.)
- I acknowledge that 100 Mile House & District Minor Hockey has implemented a 3-Strike Rule in regard to parental behaviors.
  - First occurrence, a written warning will be given.
  - Second Strike, a written warning will be given, and parent or parents will need to review and re-sign their Parent-Contract(s) and be required to complete the Respect in Sport – For Hockey Canada Parents Program, at their own cost within 7 days of the occurrence.
  - Third Strike, a written notice will be given, and the parent or parents will be banned to the Lobby during all Sanctioned minor hockey events for the remainder of the season. The ability to carry this penalty to the next season is at the discretion of the disciplinary committee.

I agree to abide by the principles of the FAIR PLAY CODE, rules, and regulations as set by Hockey Canada, BC Hockey and regulations, and decisions as set by the 100 Mile House & District Minor Hockey Association..

I understand and accept that my violation of this code may result in disciplinary action up to and including my removal from all minor hockey sanctioned events.
